

COOPERATIVE EDUCATION – *Work Education Program for Credits*



COOP IS A UNIQUE EDUCATIONAL PROCESS FOR STUDENTS TO PROMOTE SKILL DEVELOPMENT, INDIVIDUAL CAREER PLANNING AND SELF-AWARENESS BY MEANS OF INTEGRATING CLASSROOM LEARNING WITH SUPERVISED PRACTICAL EXPERIENCES IN A BUSINESS, INDUSTRY OR COMMUNITY SERVICE ORGANIZATION.

THE COOP PROGRAM enables a student to spend half the school day in a curriculum-related community work setting. Students meet regularly throughout the semester to share their experiences, reflect on their learning and participate in integration activities and assignments.

An individual **Work Education Agreement** sets the duration of time that a student spends at the worksite.

The program involves the development of an individualized training plan, monitoring of student progress by coop teachers and an evaluation by both the teacher monitor and the supervisor at the work site.

Upon successful completion of the program, a student is awarded **TWO CREDITS** toward his/her Ontario Secondary School Diploma.

TO ENROL IN A COOP PROGRAM, STUDENTS MUST :

- 1. CHOOSE** Cooperative Education on her/his course option sheet (with parental support)
- 2. SUBMIT** a completed Cooperative Education application form to the Cooperative Education Department
- 3. PARTICIPATE** in an interview with a coop teacher

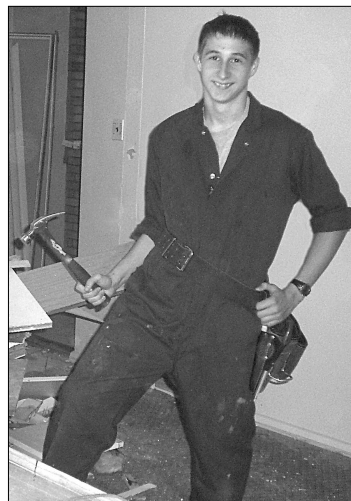
STUDENT EVALUATION is a joint responsibility of the teacher monitor and workplace supervisor, which includes:

- *written and oral reports*
- *participation in pre-placement and integration sessions*
- *Independent Study Unit - Career Exploration*
